



FCS Concept of Operations




Field FCS-Equipped Units of Action With Threshold Objective Force Capability by the End of the Decade.

Key Tenets of the Program


- Create Opportunity for Best of Industry to Participate


FCS ORD Timeline






National Defense As Percentage of GNP/GDP


Since 1900
