

Legacy Force


Selectively modernize and recapitalize the Legacy Force to guarantee warfighting readiness and to support the Objective Force as we transform






PEO/PM Reorganization




The PEO/PM reorganization is approved for immediate implementation.

Current PEO/PM Structure






