

Transforming the Navy Sea Strike

- <u>Global CONOPs</u>: Draw on forward-deployed, dispersed, yet networked, combat power to provide the JTF Commander with tailored Naval Capability Packages from among:
 - 12 Carrier Strike Groups,
 - 12 Expeditionary Strike Groups,
 - multiple missile-defense Surface Action Groups
 - Guided-missile submarines
- operate independently to counter transnational threats
- join together to form Expeditionary Strike Forces



Transforming the Navy Sea Trial

Expeditionary Strike Group

- Consists of a traditional Amphibious Ready Group PLUS:
 - AEGIS Cruiser Fast attack submarine
 - Guided Missile Destroyer(s)
- P-3 maritime patrol aircraft
- East and West Coast Proofs of Concept being tested in 2003
- N4 will be a 3100 0-5 with a USMC 0-4 Log Planner as deputy
 - Log planning for STOM
 - LFORM reconfiguration
 - Material readiness (Ground/Air/Ship) Blue/Green sustainment
- Maintenance Support
 - Ordnance


Transforming NAVSUP Structural Changes
