

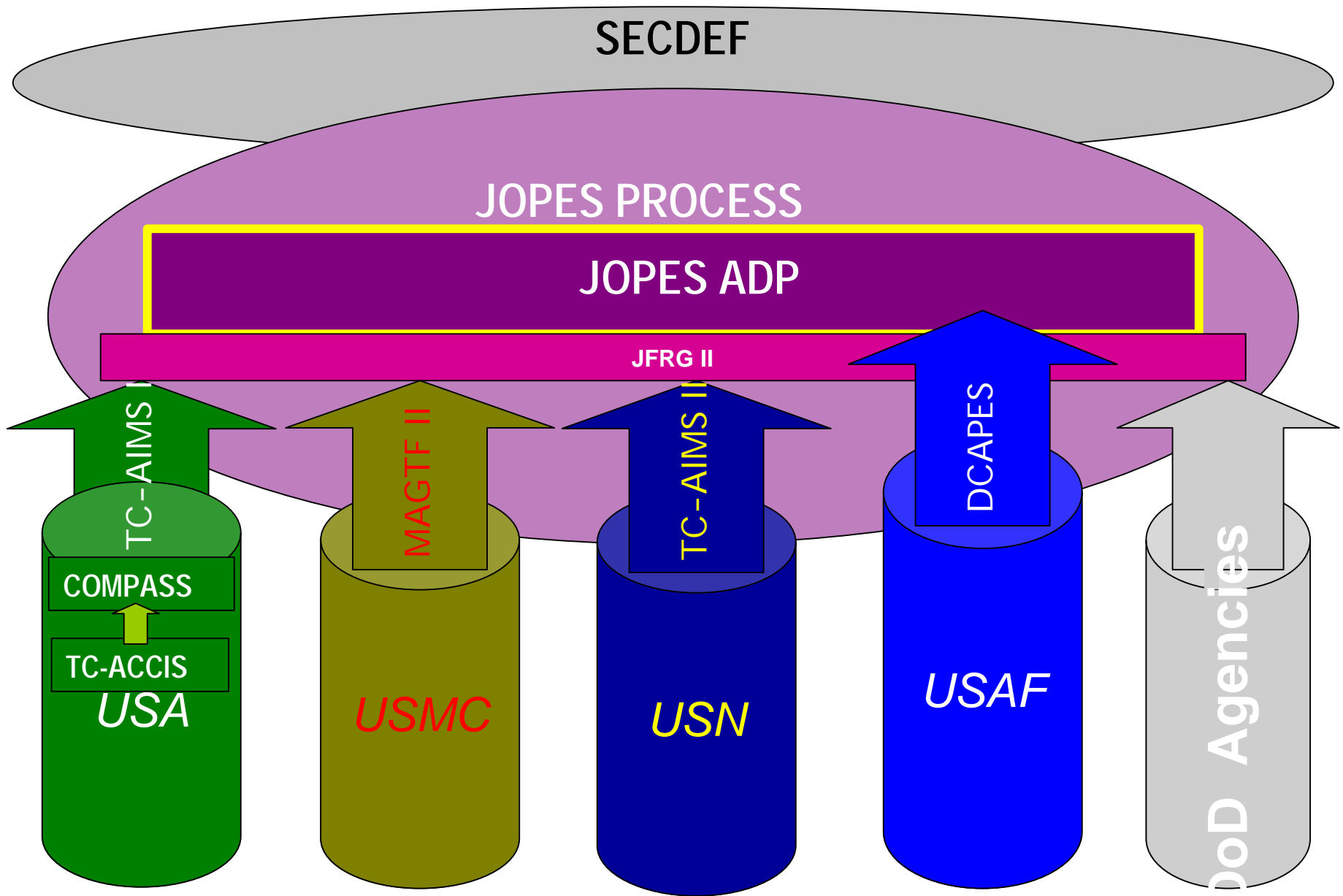

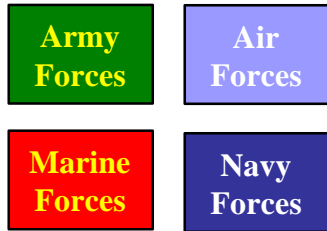
USJFCOM Mission

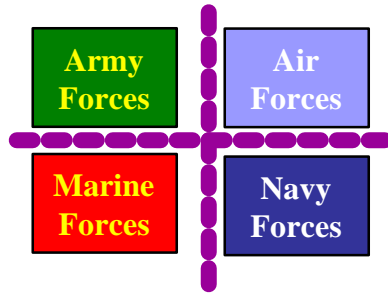

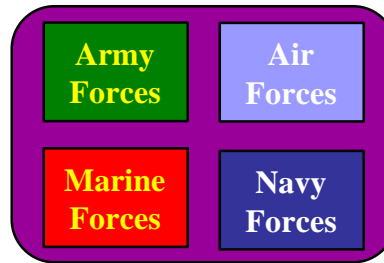

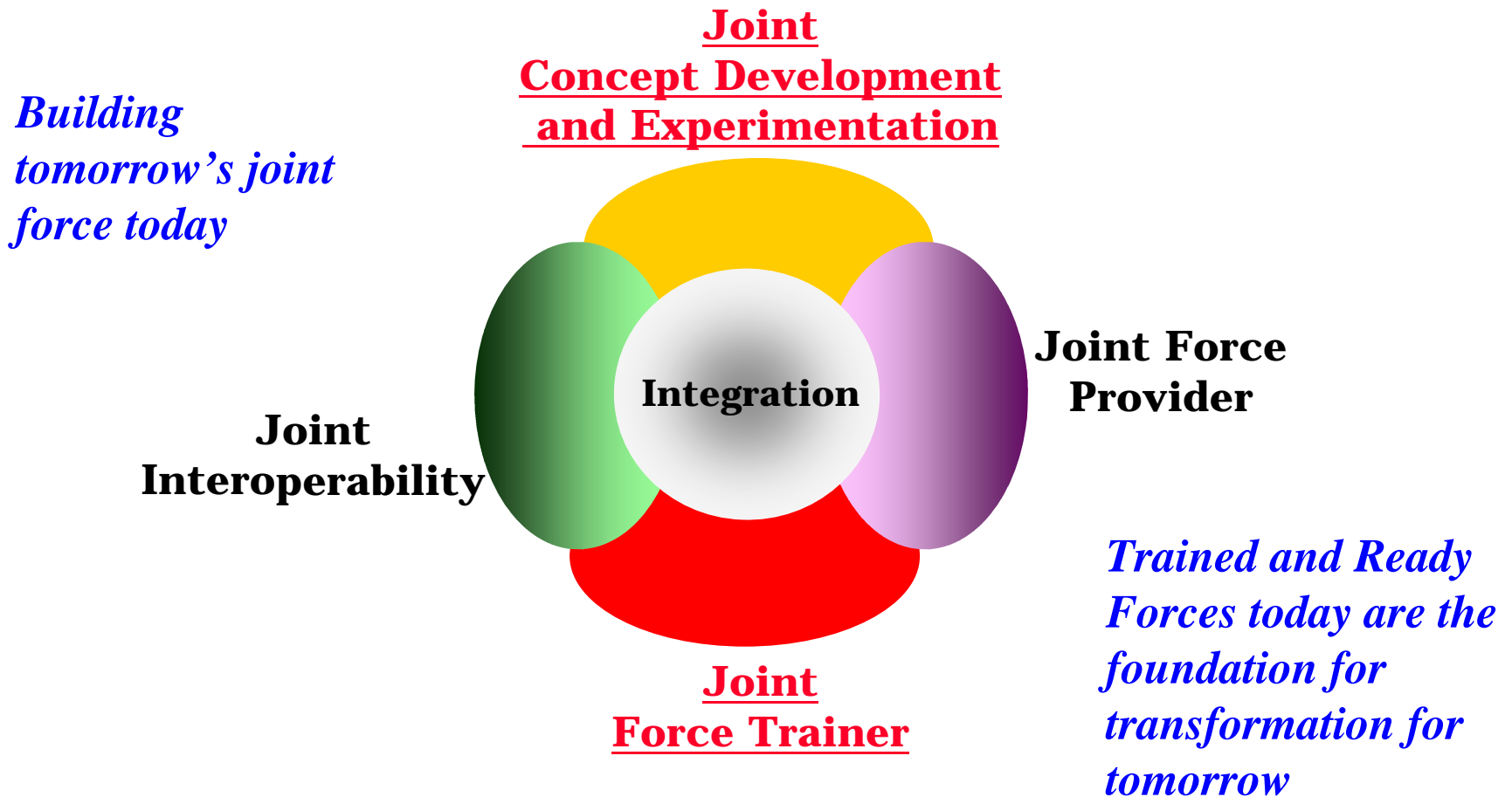
