Getting to Fort Belvoir & Access Information

Vehicles that do not have DoD registration decals <u>MUST enter Fort Belvoir through the Tulley Gate</u>. Stop at the visitors center located at Tully Gate. Drivers will be required to show vehicle registration or rental car documentation in order to receive a temporary vehicle pass. The driver and all passengers will be required to show a valid picture ID (Drivers licenses or passport) when entering through Tulley Gate.

DAU is located at 9820 Belvoir Road, Ft. Belvoir, VA 22060-5565

FROM RONALD REAGAN NAT'L AIRPORT

Travel south on Route 1/Richmond Highway through Alexandria to Fort Belvoir. There are many traffic lights, fast food places, and gas stations. An alternate route (15.3 miles) would be to take scenic George Washington/Mt. Vernon Parkway (named Washington Street in town) south through Old Town Alexandria. From the airport's main terminal, follow the green highway signs toward Alexandria. Proceed along the Potomac River past Mt. Vernon, historic home of George Washington, until you get to the Route 1 intersection; turn left (south) on Route 1. Go up the hill for approx one mile; turn left and go through the Tulley Gate. Follow the road through Tulley Gate and turn right onto Gunston Road. Turn left onto 18th Street. Turn right into the DAU Campus located between 18th and 19th Streets. To get to Fort Belvoir from Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport by using the "Metrorail" subway in combination with bus services. Take Metrorail to the Pentagon and transfer to bus 9A; be sure you have exact change for the bus. When you arrive at Fort Belvoir, exit at the intersections of either 18th Street and Gunston or 18th and Belvoir Road.

From I-95 Traveling South

Take this interstate south until you are below Springfield, and take exit #166 onto Route 7100 (Newington/ Fort Belvoir exit). From this ramp you travel southeast on the Fairfax County Parkway (commonly known as Backlick Road) to Route 1/Richmond Highway. Turn left (north) onto Route 1 where you will immediately see the Tulley Gate entrance to your right. **Stop at the Visitors**Center to receive a Temporary Vehicle Pass. Follow the road through Tulley Gate and turn right onto Gunston Road. Turn left onto 18th Street. Turn right into the DAU Campus located between 18th and 19th Street.

From Richmond I-95 Traveling North

Take I-95 north to the Fort Belvoir/Mt. Vernon exit. You will now be on Route 1/ Richmond Highway. Take Route 1 for approx 6 miles to the Tulley Gate entrance to your right. Stop at the Visitors Center to receive a Temporary Vehicle Pass. Follow the road through Tulley Gate and turn right onto Gunston Road. Turn left onto 18th Street. Turn right into the DAU Campus located between 18th and 19th Streets.

From the Maryland Side of the Beltway

Take the Beltway (I-495) across the Potomac River via the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and continue on I-495 to the exit for I-95. Go south on I-95 toward Richmond. (See From I-95 Traveling South.)
