


- Purpose



- Smoke




- Human Effects reviews to determine:

mps = meters per second




Employment and Tactics


- Force Protection / Mobile Security.
 - Airbursts in front of approaching vessel.
 - Desired effect. Approaching vessel halts or changes course.
- Patrol and Interdiction.
 - Airbursts ahead of fleeing vessel.
 - Desired effect. Fleeing vessel halts.
