 - Based on CSI five level numbering system

- UFGS five level numbering system

- Level 1 - **31** 00 00 Earthwork
 - Level 2 – 31 **41** 00 Shoring
 - Level 3 – 31 41 **16** Sheet Piling
 - Level 4 – 31 41 16.**11**
 - » for activity or project specific use
 - » for very unique narrow scope UFGS (minimal)
 - Level 5 – 31 41 16.11 **10** Designation for non-unified sections
 - » 10 Army
 - » 20 Navy
 - » 30 NASA
 - » 40 Veterans Administration
 - » 50 – 90 Future participating agencies
