

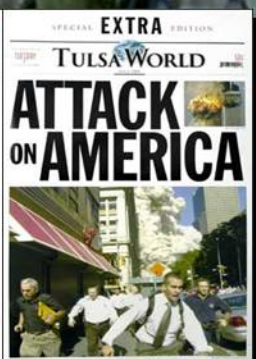

A New Operational Force



In the worst attack on U.S. soil since Pearl Harbor, two planes crashed into hijacked airplanes into the World Trade Center and brought down the 110-story towers this morning.

A jetliner also slammed into the Pentagon as the government itself raced to evacuate the area.

United States

A fourth jetliner, also possibly hijacked, crashed in rural Pennsylvania about 16 miles from Pittsburgh.

Thousands could be killed or injured, officials said. So far, no jet has claimed responsibility for the attacks, but suspicion has been cast on Osama bin Laden, who also has been linked to the attack on the World's Second Trade Center.

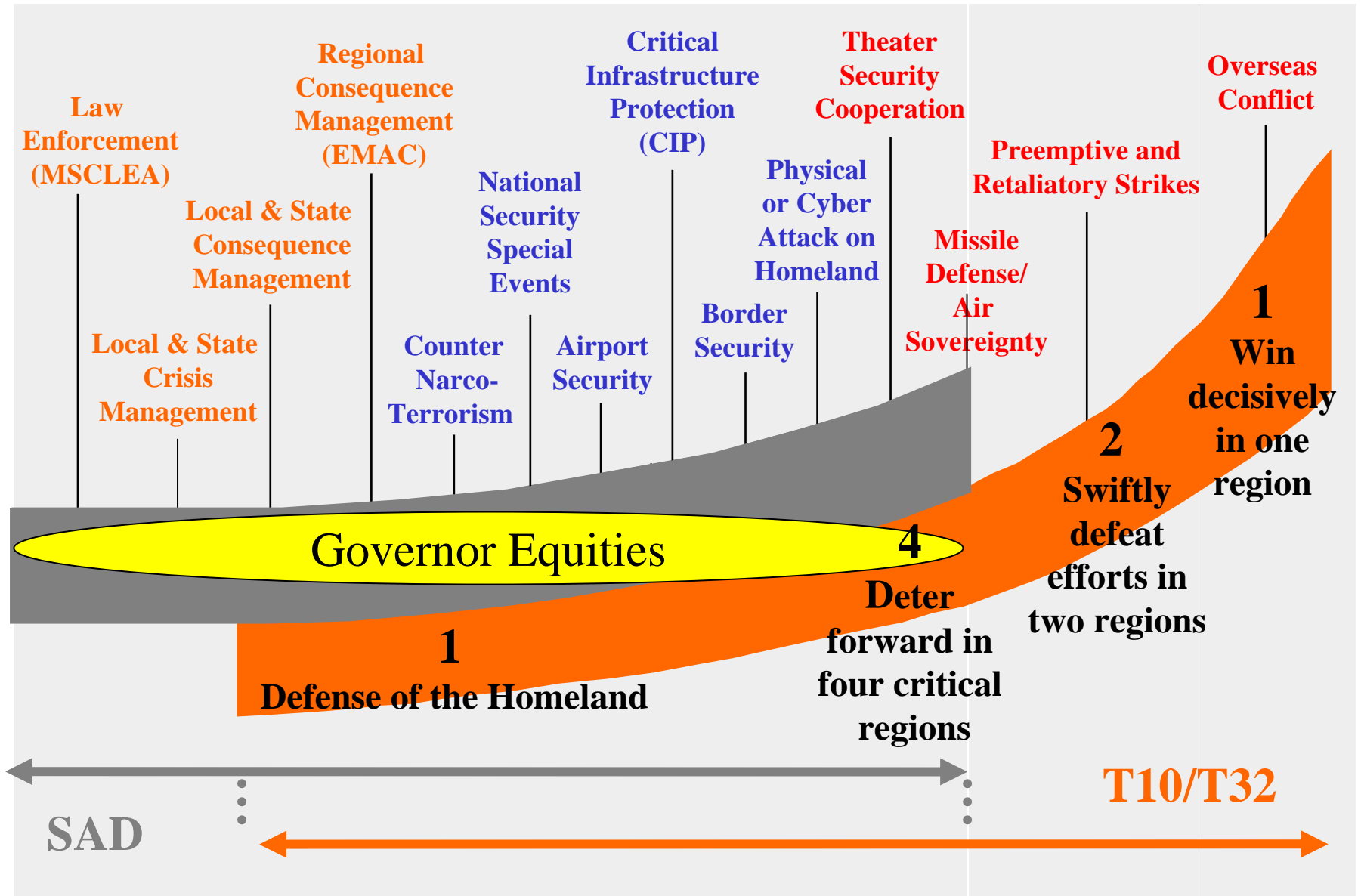

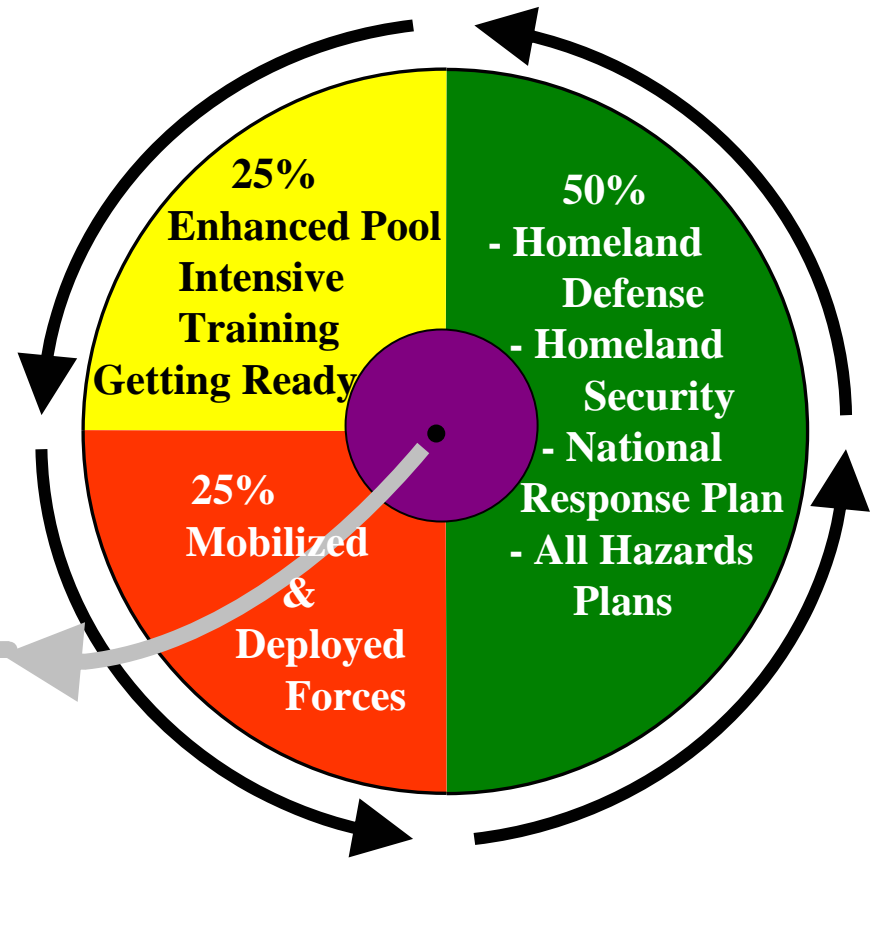
Continuum of Operations

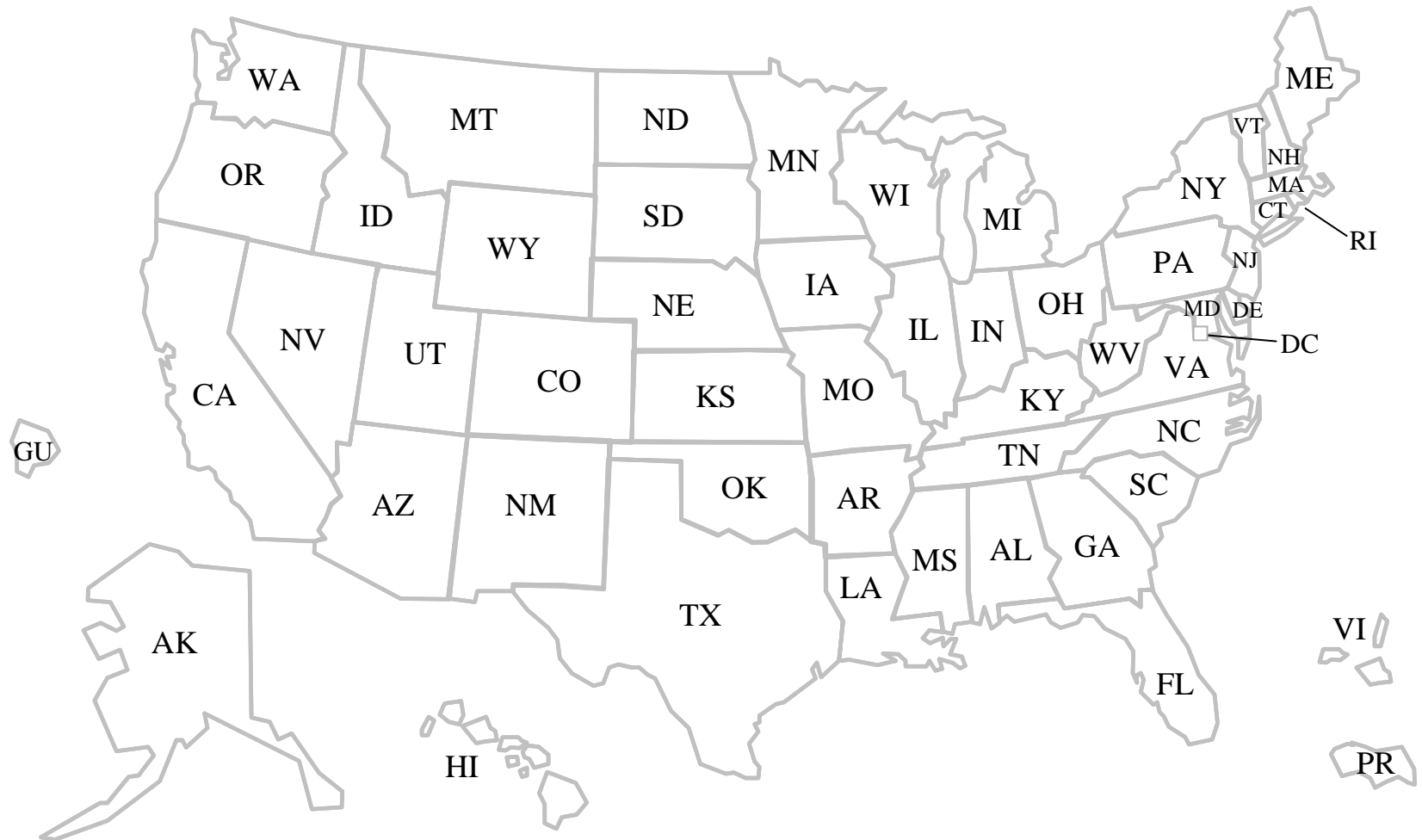


Equipment Readiness Shortfall

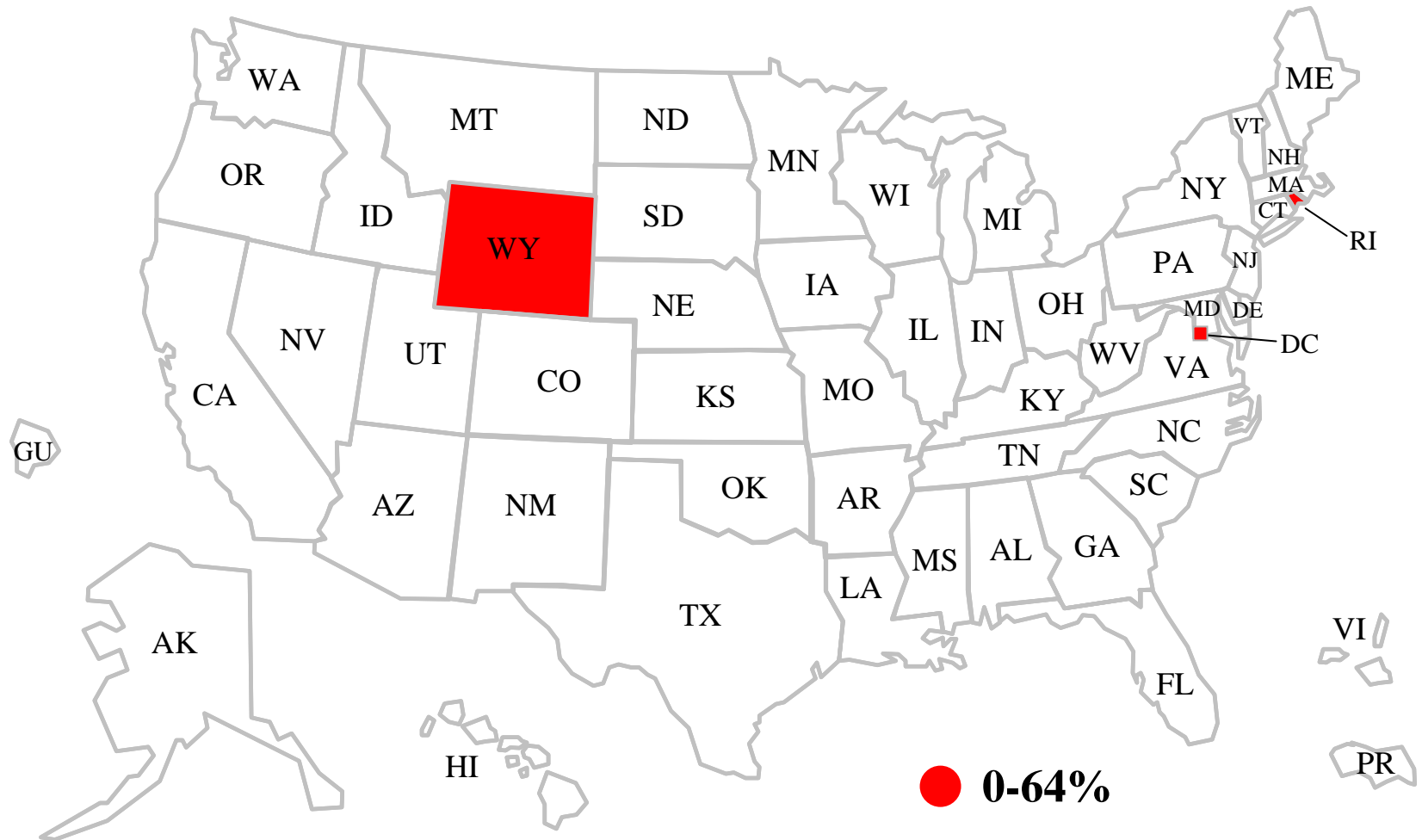
88% of the ARNG and 45% of the ANG here in the United States are not ready due to lack of equipment.



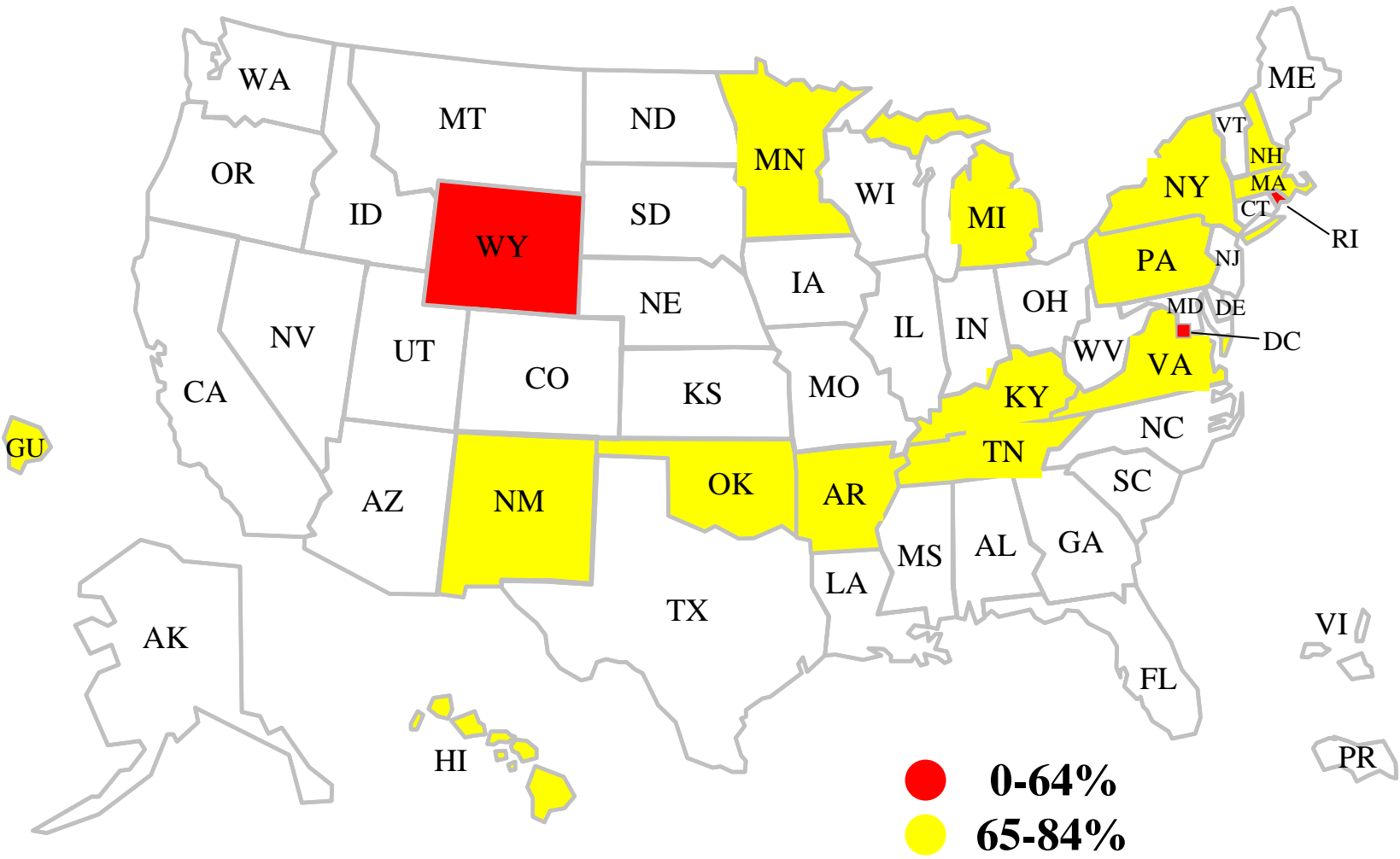
ANG Equipment Available to Govs for HLD



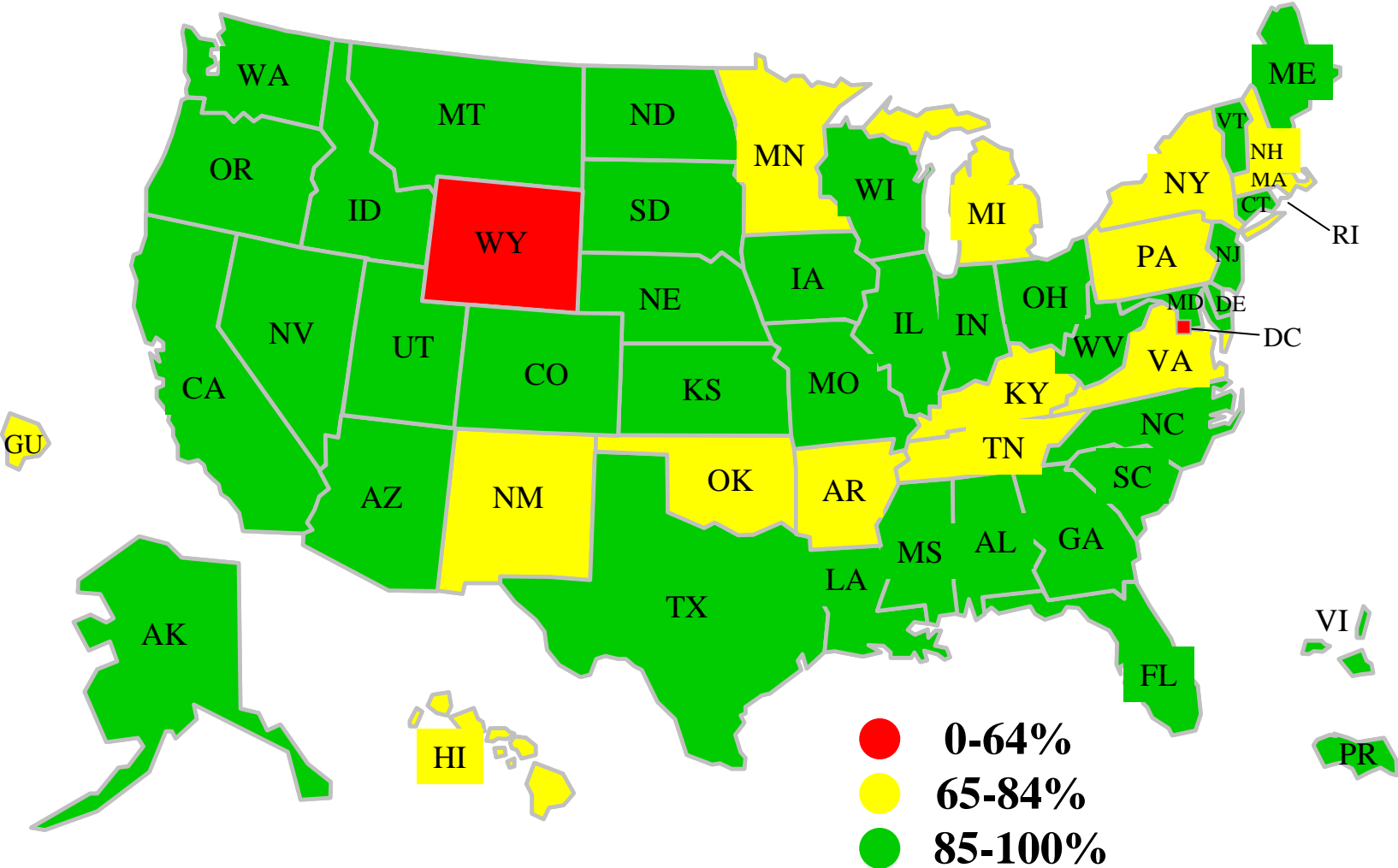
