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Scope

Projects will focus on the development and demonstration of prototypes in an operational environment

Roles for Biometrics within DoD

- Military Operations
 - Combat Identification
 - Intelligence
 - Detention Operations

- Business Operations
 - Physical Access
 - Logical Access

Desired End State – Projects will lead to the proof of technological feasibility and an assessment of component operability with potential to transition






Focus Areas

- Collection Systems
 - Develop the capability to obtain biometric data as well as all related biographical and/or situational data
- Sub-Optimal Data Enhancement
 - Provide solutions to poor data quality created through challenges in collection and storage
- Next Generation Algorithms
 - Meet the changing algorithm requirements and develop a product that can be shared across the DoD and the federal government
- Biometrics Data Fusion
 - Combine multiple biometric modalities and other non-biometric data to allow for improved matching and more robust identity analysis
- Biometrics Architecture
 - Provide solutions that support a complex and evolving infrastructure

Evaluation Criteria

Scientific / Technical Merit

The overall scientific and/or technical merit of the proposal

Support to the Mission

 The potential contributions of the effort to the DoD mission and the extent to which the research will contribute to balancing the overall biometrics program

Offeror's Capabilities

 The offeror's capabilities, related experience, facilities, techniques, or unique combinations of these, which are integral factors for achieving the proposed objectives

Principal Investigator Qualifications

 The qualifications, capabilities, and experience of the proposed principal investigator, team leader, or other key personnel who are critical to achievement of the proposed objectives

Past Performance

Offeror's record of past performance

Budget

The reasonableness and realism of proposed costs, any fee, and the availability
 of funds
