
Development Planning Guidance



- Weapon System Acquisition Reform Act (WSARA 2009: PL 111-23)
 - Directed acquisition improvements through early SE and DP activities
 - OSD ATL Directive-Type Memorandum (DTM) 10-017 – Development Planning to Inform Materiel Development Decision (MDD) Reviews and Support Analyses of Alternatives (AoA)

Each service has their own advocacy, oversight and execution responsibility

- 2010 Army Acquisition Review
 - "Major Problems Hamper Acquisition"
 - Make Requirements ProcessCollaborative and Timely





OSD Tenets of Development Planning



Components shall provide evidence at the MDD Review that will facilitate the MDA's determination that:

- The candidate materiel solution approaches have the potential to effectively address the capability gap(s), desired operational attributes, and associated dependencies
- There exists a range of technically feasible solutions generated from across the entire solution space, as demonstrated through early prototypes, models, or data
- Consideration has been given to near-term opportunities to provide a more rapid interim response to the capability need
- The plan to *staff and fund analytic, engineering, and programmatic activities* supports the proposed milestone entry requirements




Army DP Definition:

Aligning Operational, Technology and Acquisition Management activities to:

- 1) Reduce program risk at an MDD
- 2) Support acquisition planning & decision making for Force Modernization


Technical and Operational Focus

- Feeds Army S&T investments (S&T Strategic Planning)
- Transitions S&T to Acquisition early
- Provides foundation for an S&T and Acquisition Decision




