## **UNSOLICITED PROPOSALS**

Make sure your unsolicited proposal offers a unique <u>and</u> innovative method or approach <u>and</u> that the offer is of significant technological promise toward the accomplishment of our mission.

A valid unsolicited proposal must be independently originated and developed, prepared without Government supervision, and provides sufficient detail for Government review, but must not be an advance proposal for a known MARCORSYSCOM requirement.

Submission of an unsolicited proposal does not in any way guarantee a contract award.

## **HELPFUL HINTS**

- Submit quality proposals.
  - Verify pricing before submitting proposals.
  - "Sharpen your pencils"
- Cooperate with the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA).
  - When being audited.
  - Provide requested information / documentation timely.
- Be prepared to negotiate.
  - Shrinking budgets.
  - "Better Buying Power Initiatives" MARCORSYSCOM's focus is on competition and reducing costs / price in **every** acquisition.
