




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Current Outlook Land







Current Outlook Maritime








Current Outlook Land Class IX Orders

Strategic Focus Area		Description	Expected Benefit

2.	Decrease Direct Material Costs	"Be Smart Buyers of the Right Stuff" Reduce the direct cost of fuel by 1-3% across all fuel products.
