

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#### **Reverse Auctioning Defined**





A process that allows government contractors to bid against each other in a real-time, on-line auction.




Used as a pricing technique during discussions to drive down pricing.

Used in conjunction with the evaluation factors stated elsewhere in the solicitation (past performance, socioeconomic factors, etc.).






# What procurement dollar range would attract your participation in a reverse auction?

#### Land and Maritime FY 12

Competitive, large dollar procurements

- One-time-buys
- Long-Term Contracts (LTCs)





**RA prices will be used with the evaluation factors** in the solicitation to make the award decision

The Contracting Officer (KO) will provide offerors in the competitive range with information concerning the on-line auction process

**Discussions** can be conducted prior to or simultaneously with the RA

The **lowest offeror's price(s**) for each round of the RA will be **anonymously** disclosed to other offerors

An offeror's **final auction price** at the close of the RA will be considered its **final proposal revision** 







When competing a delivery order using RA, the KO will **notify the contractor via email** 

RA prices will be **used with the evaluation factors** in the contract or solicitation to make the award decision

Prior to RA, the **government will determine whether all participants' prices, or just the lowest price(s), will be anonymously disclosed** to auction participants and to others authorized access to the RA

Final auction price(s) at the close of the RA will be considered final proposed prices

  - POC for conducting the auction

Online provider notification

- Email address is from online provider with auction POC, not "DLA.Mil"
  - Bulk mail
- Time and Date of auction event
- Directions to complete registration
  - Accept terms

- ✓ Determine pricing strategy

	3. Procedures and Rules. Participant further agrees to be bound by the procedures and rules established by the Site and Sponsor.

This means that an additional period of time will be added to the event when a new low bid is received within the "Quiet Period," by this application, prior to the closing of the event. As a result, there is no advantage in waiting until the last possible moment to submit a new bid. You will notice during the event that there is a time difference between when you click the "submit your bid" button and the bids' recorded receipt. Such time differences are normal for any internet based application. Experience has shown that this time difference with each bid, and is outside the control of Ariba, the Government, or any of our vendors. Waiting for the last moment to submit a new low bid cannot give you advantage, as time will be added to the clock. However, if you wait too long to submit your bid, it will be rejected if it is not received by this application prior to the closing the event that that you do not wait until the last minute to submit a bid. If no new low offers are received during this event, the Contracting Officer will proceed with the award process based on the initial responses to this solicitation.


