



### How can you help us?

- Industrial base is part of our team. We *must* work together.

- Under-execution and under-performance will lead to further cuts and destabilization.







# Increasingly interconnected world with competition for resources and littoral migration while...

#### Adversaries are trying to:

- Deny coalition freedom of action (A2/AD)
- Avoid defeat while simultaneously raising the cost of our operations
- Disrupt the global economic system
- Avoid our detection and strike capabilities by blending in with civilian populations and maritime traffic
- Attempt to deny our benefits of air superiority
- Exploit civilian networks for their own C4I
- Employ combined arms across domains for both long-range strikes and close-in ambushes

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
