Ammunition Logistics



JMC has **8** logistics locations in the continental United States, **5** centers for distribution and **3** for long term storage. Assets occupy **11,784** storage igloos/magazines with more than **30 Million** gross square feet of storage space. These warehouses store munitions valued at over **\$61B**, providing assets to the Joint Services worldwide. In Fiscal Year 2013, JMC processed **50,000 sales/delivery** orders and shipped a total tonnage equivalent to **11,400** containers.

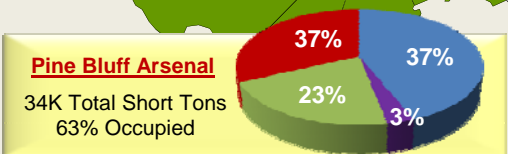
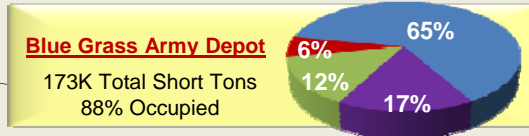
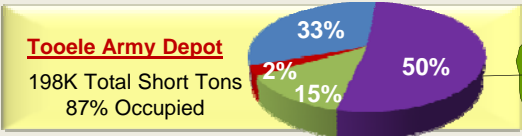
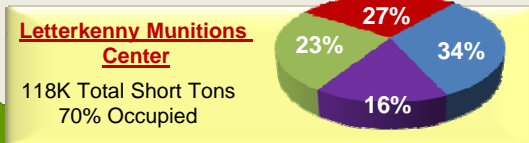
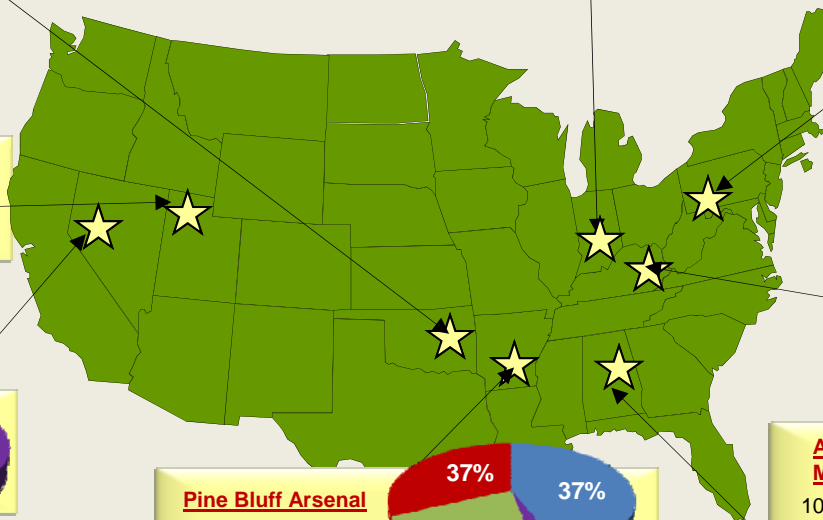


Logistics JMC Footprint

- Army missile and retail

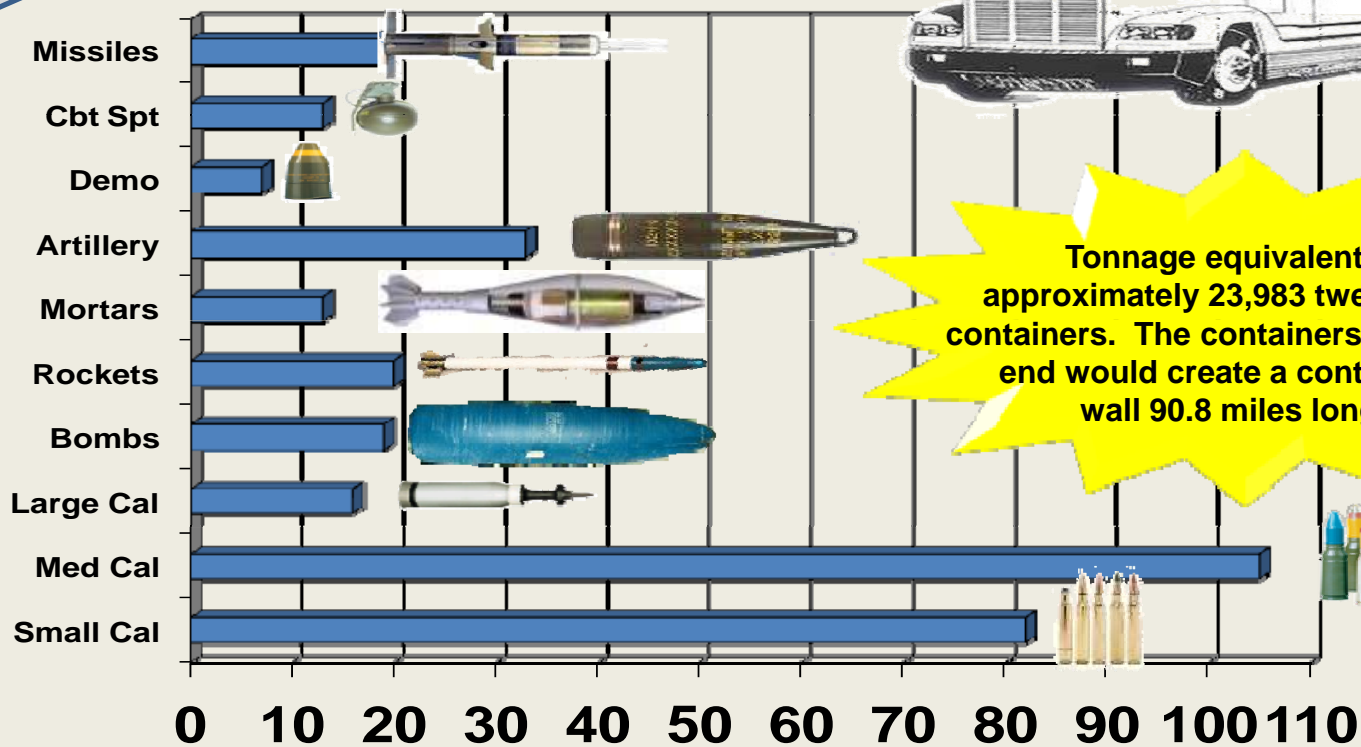
Ammunition Storage Capacity for All Services

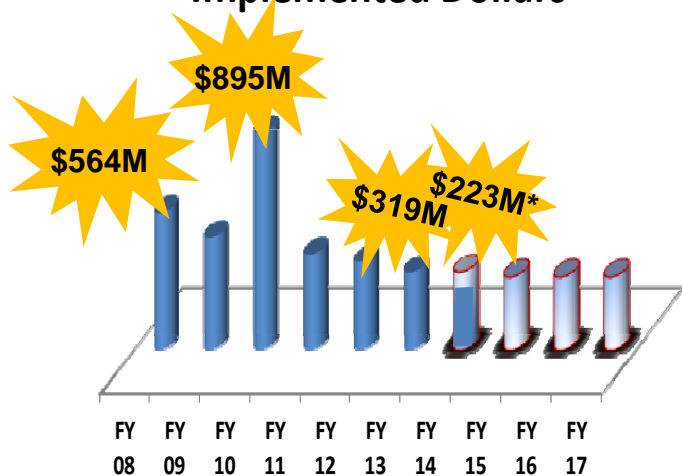

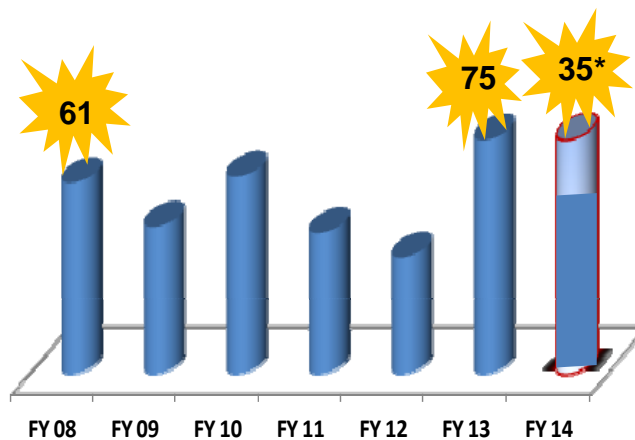


Sales still strong for CENTCOM area of responsibility – followed by PACOM

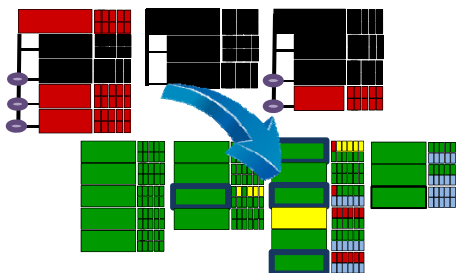

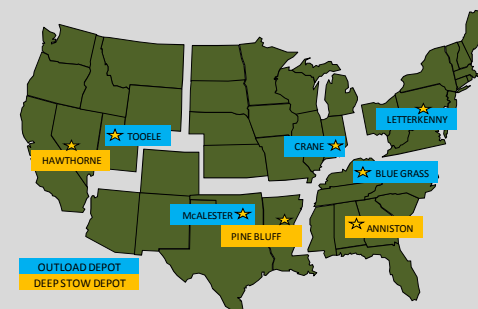
