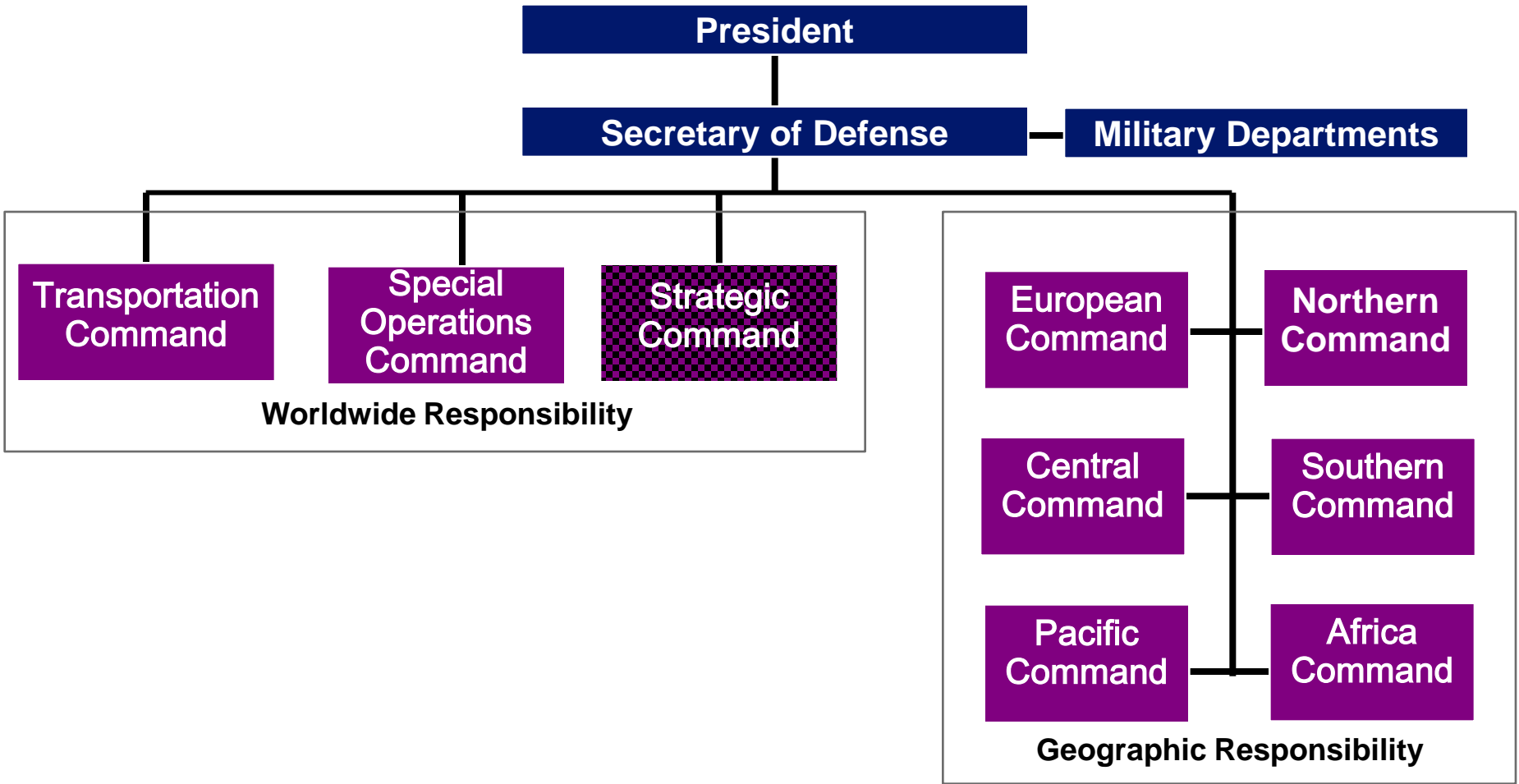

Evolution of USSTRATCOM



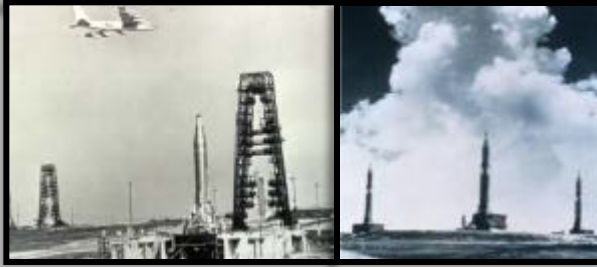

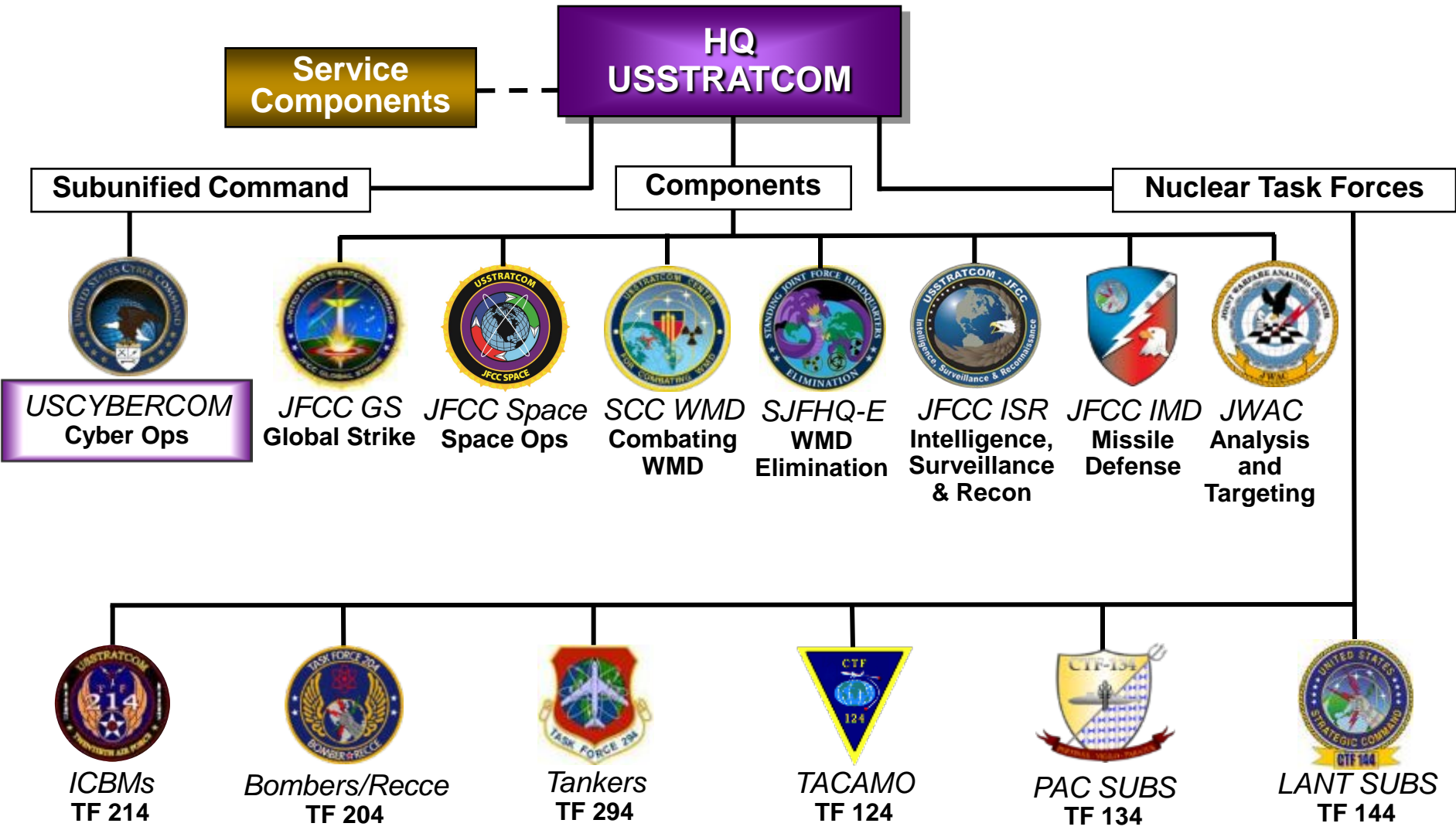
