

IR&D: Why is it important?



- DoD and industry benefit from IR&D efforts to address technical challenges

 reduce cost, technical and schedule risk early.
- IR&D as Market Research: DoD uses the IR&D Secure Portal to find projects that address, mitigate, or improve a DoD technical challenge transition to a program of record.
 - Only approved and registered DoD government employees or military can access the Portal.
- Encourages greater contribution to technology related to future defense systems; all projects summaries are aligned to a COI / COI Sub Area,
- Creates technology surprise.
- Hedges against the uncertainties, inflexibilities and short time horizon of defense planning and systems development.
- Translates new ideas and technologies into defense capabilities.

Quickly discover DoD research projects and documents, as well as people, places and content from the DoDTechSpace community on your topic of interest.

Analytics (https://cbat.dtic.mil/)

Through this tool you can access S&T funding information via the Unified R&E Database and other sources such as Congressional budget information.

Defense Innovation Marketplace (http://www.defenseinnovationmarketplace.mil/)

A resource for industry to view DoD S&T planning documents, acquisition resources, funding and financial information. It is also where industry submits proprietary Industry R&D (IR&D) summary reports for compliance with the Defense Federal Acquisition Supplement.
