
SERVICES SIGNIFICANCE

- Services acquisitions are more than half of all DOD contracting dollars spent in support of the Warfighter
- Congressional Interest, GAO Reports, Fraud Reports
- Senior Leadership Emphasis: Improving Tradecraft in Acquisition of Services is one of the seven USD(AT&L) Better Buying Power (BBP) 2.0 focus areas.
 - Potential for cost reduction and improved efficiencies
- Services touches everyone military, civilian, E1 010, GS-3 to SES Until now they have had very little services acquisition specific training





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 Acquisition Strategy has been shaped by input from Industry as part of various market research activities


FUTURE BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES HQ

- SOCOM Wide Mission Support (SWMS) (Task Orders)
 - \$1.5B Source Selection in Process: \$150M Service Disabled, Veteran Owned Small Business; \$450M Small Business; \$900M full and open
- SITEC
 - \$3.5B scheduled for 2016
 - Small business set asides are undetermined
- SOFSA
 - \$5B scheduled for FY17
 - Currently 25% Small business





LREC

- Develop, validate, and execute Joint SOF LREC training, training delivery means, and training materials
- Study, identify, and implement methods to increase SOF LREC capability and report readiness
