Remote Weapon System Requirements




- Capable of being resistant to the environmental (salt water).
- 125 lbs
- Must be compatible with current power requirements.
- Able to incorporate lethal as well as non-lethal capabilities.



Non-Lethal Weapons



- Hail and Warning Laser
- Non-Lethal Impact Mmunition (NLIM)
- Small Naval Arresting Rope Entangler (SNARE)
- Hailing, Acoustic, Laser, Light Tactical System (HALLTS)
- LA51 Hail and Warning Mmunition
