

Overview of Terms

Mission Thread: A description of doctrinal concepts and activities.

Mission Pattern: A representative ISR Analytical Technique, depicted with supporting Events and Actions, in support of a typical C2 request.

Context – Typhoon then terrorists!

Problem – Al Foxxn actors are stealing humanitarian supplies from convoys

- NGA, Provide Regional Maps for Country Studies
- ☑ DCGS-Navy , Provide Common Intel Picture (CIP)
- ☑ DCGS- Marine Corps , Support ground ops with Object-Based Production (OBP)
- ✓ DCGS-Army , Provide threat warning support using Network Analysis
- ✓ Air Force DCGS, Coordinate airborne ISR with Overwatch Mission
- ✓ DCGS-SOF, Support HVT ops using Pattern of Life Analysis
- ☐ US BICES-X , Support Host Nation Data Sharing
- □ **DCGS-IC**, Support national data sharing in theatre
 - ☑ Mission Pattern referenced herein
 - ☐ Future Mission Pattern



Acronyms

BICES-X = Battlefield Information Collection and Exploitation Systems - Extended

CSG = Carrier Strike Group

DCGS = Distributed Common Ground/Surface System

ESG = Expeditionary Strike Group

HVT = High Value Targets

TF = Task Force


