Create Technology Transfer Policy for Army Foreign Military and Commercial Sales (~7000 Licenses Reviewed Annually)



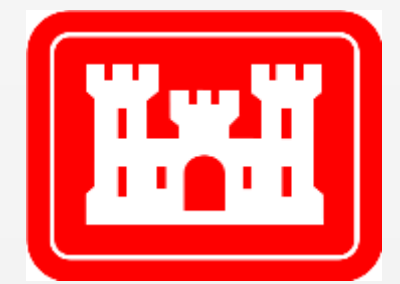

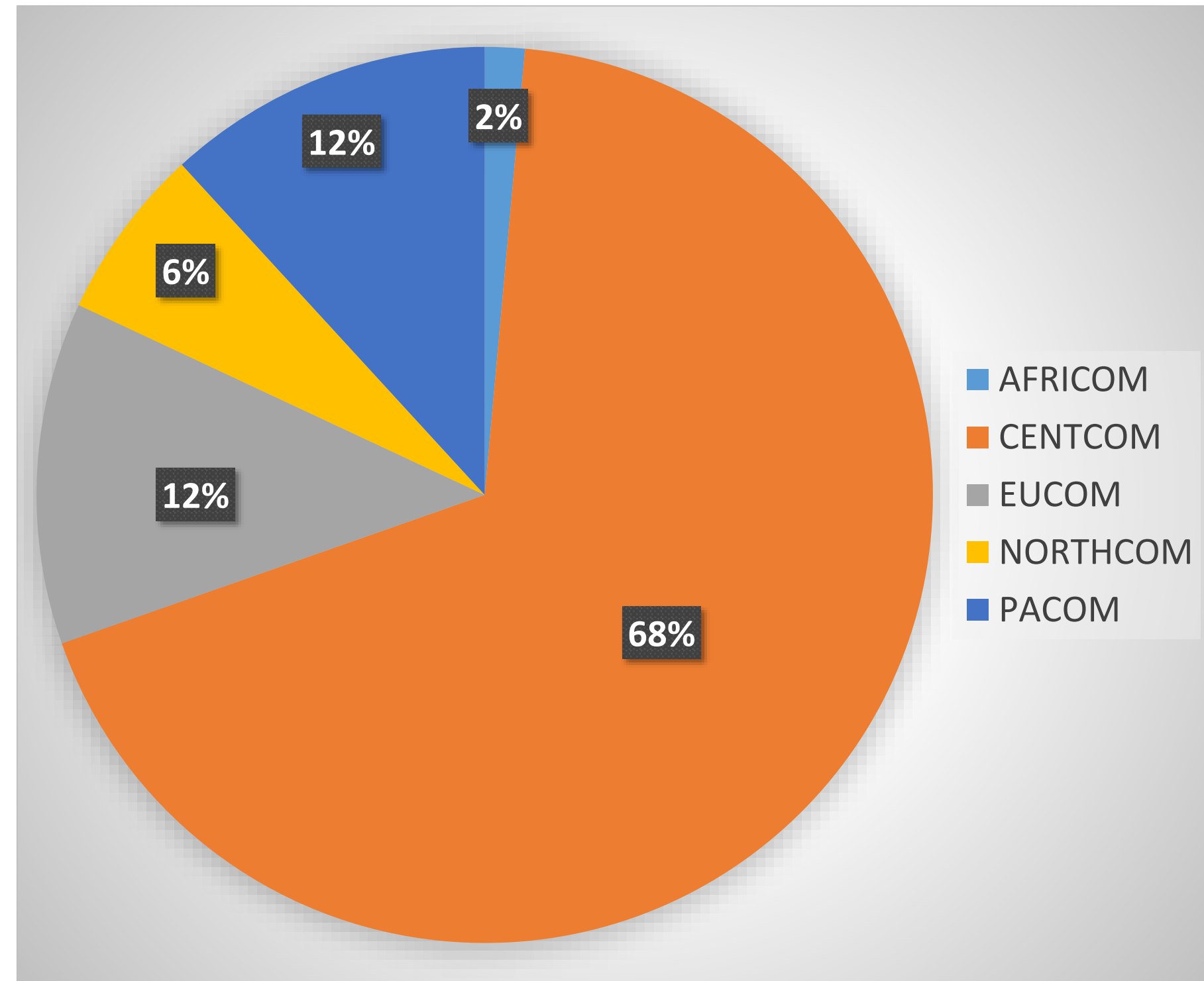
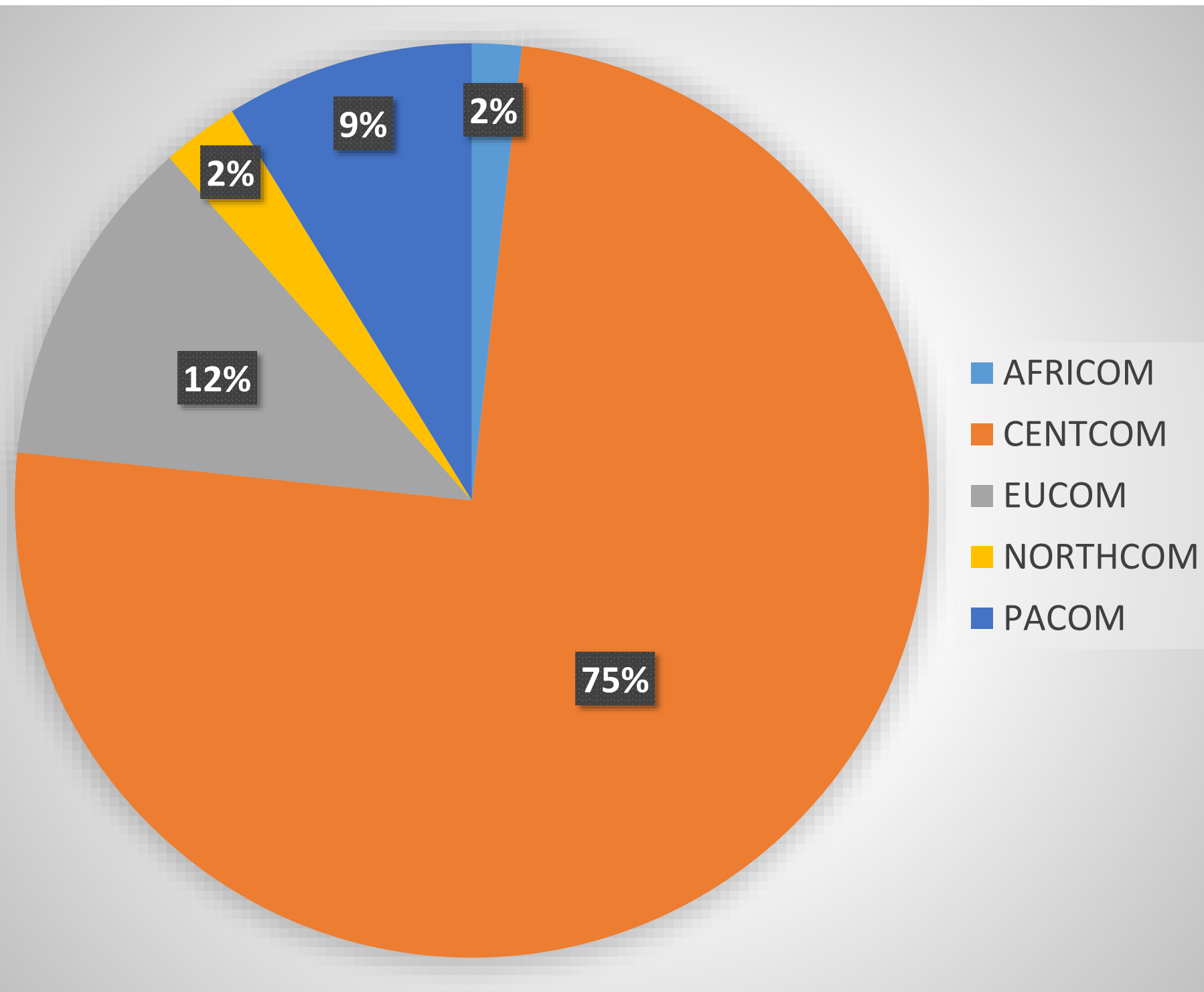


US Army Precision Strike “In the Current Fight”

Precision Guided Systems Quantity by Combatant Command (FY2012-16)

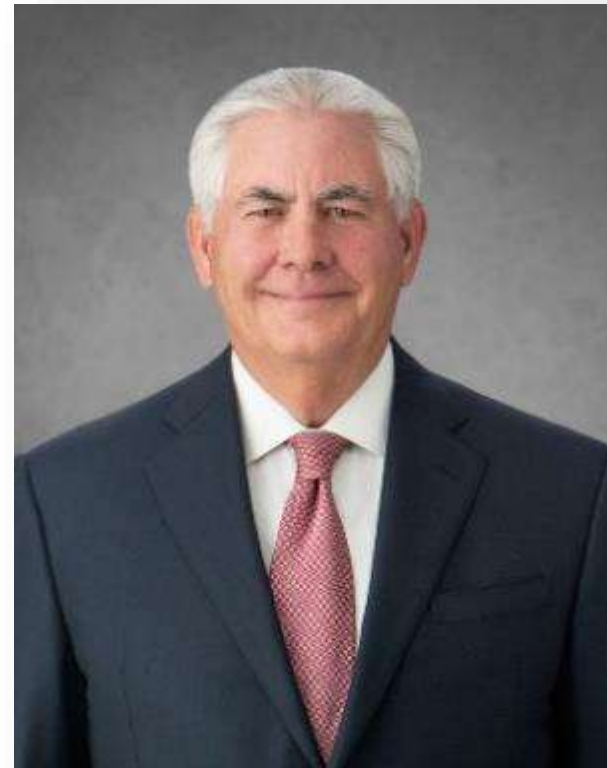
