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# *The Facts Behind the IACs*

- Under auspices of ASD(R&E) and DTIC, the IACs follow a GOCO (government owned, contractor operated) model
- Via the IACs, research & development is performed for a (largely) DoD audience to answer recurring challenges across the full range of DoD technology and knowledge interests, providing solutions to the DoD research and acquisition communities and Combatant Commands.
- The IAC program is composed of thousands of scientists and engineers. Through over 270 Task Order (TOs), IACs conduct more than \$1.3 billion in FY16 for research, development, technical studies, and analysis.

  - Solicitation # **FA8075-17-R-0001**
- Teaming event sponsored by Deltek at the Hyatt, Tysons Corner, on May 10
- Final RFP to be released in June 2017
- Award by 30 Sept 2018
  - Pool 1 (F&O): 10-20 contracts
  - Pool 2 (SB): ~10 contracts
  - Pool 3 (CBRN): 4-6 contracts
