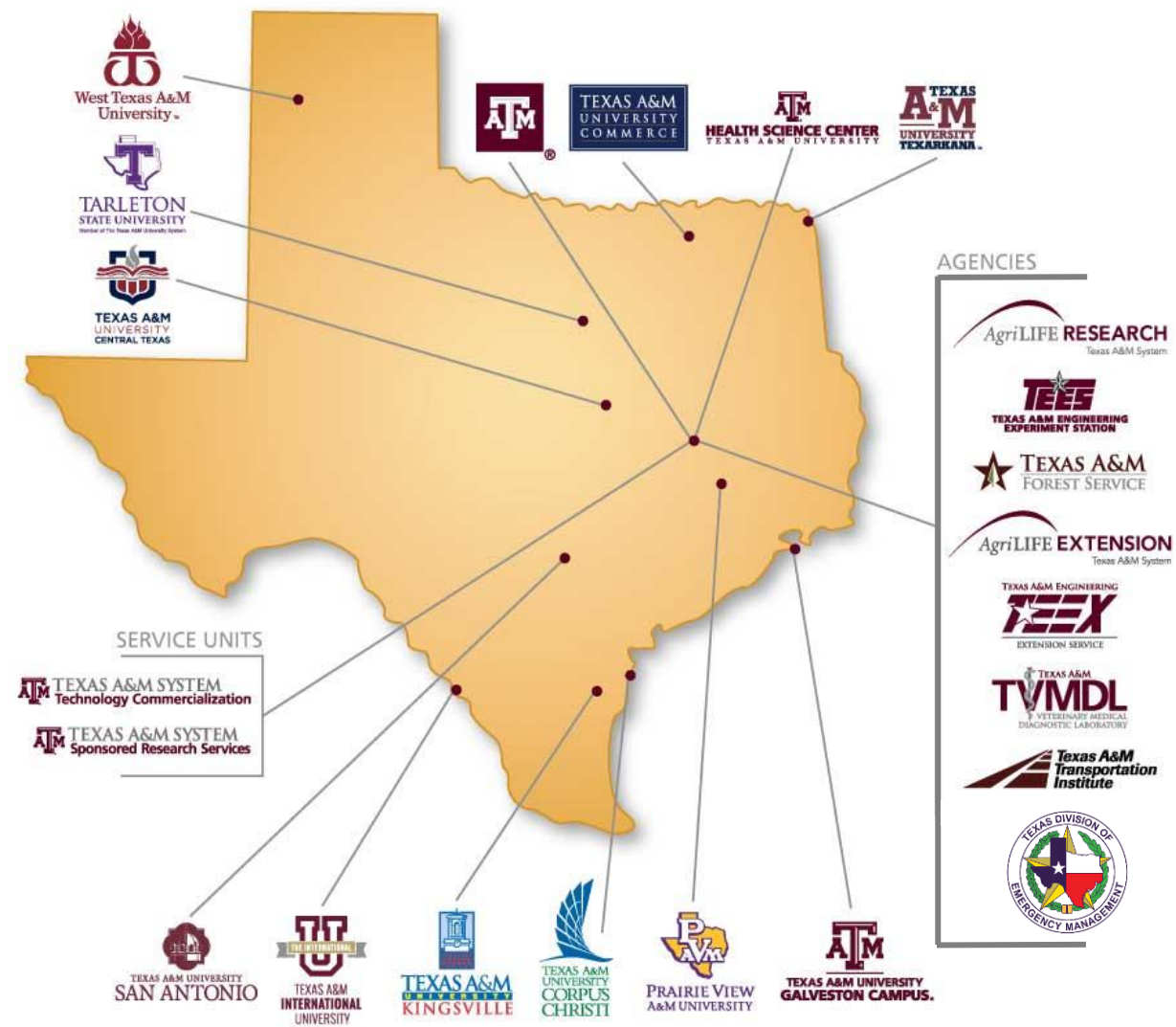
Texas A&M System is Trusted with Classified Material

- Cleared as defense contractor since 1974 by National Industrial Security Program.
- Six consecutive superior ratings, dating back to 2012, on Security Vulnerability Assessments.
- Awarded in 2015 the prestigious James S. Cogswell Award for Outstanding Industrial Security.
- Recognized in 2017 and 2019 for Excellence in Counterintelligence by DOD agency overseeing technology and workforce protections. (Only academic institution twice recognized.)



The Reach of The Texas A&M University System

- Service**
 - **22 million citizens** served annually through service/extension agencies and organizations
- Education**
 - **151,000 students** are taught annually by **28,000 faculty/staff** at our **11 campuses**
- Research**
 - **Annual expenditures >\$1B** primarily driven by agriculture, engineering, environmental and public health research and development
- Training**
 - **200,000 individuals from 105 countries** trained in fire fighting & emergency services, security, search & rescue, public works

Founded in 1876 to Serve the U.S. Military

A&M Corps of Cadets Graduates

- Served in every U.S. conflict from Spanish American War through Iraq and Afghanistan
- At least 264 became general and flag officers
- Nine earned four-star rank
- Seven awarded the Medal of Honor (Eight Aggies in all)
- More Aggies commissioned as U.S. Armed Forces officers than graduates from any other college besides the service academies.

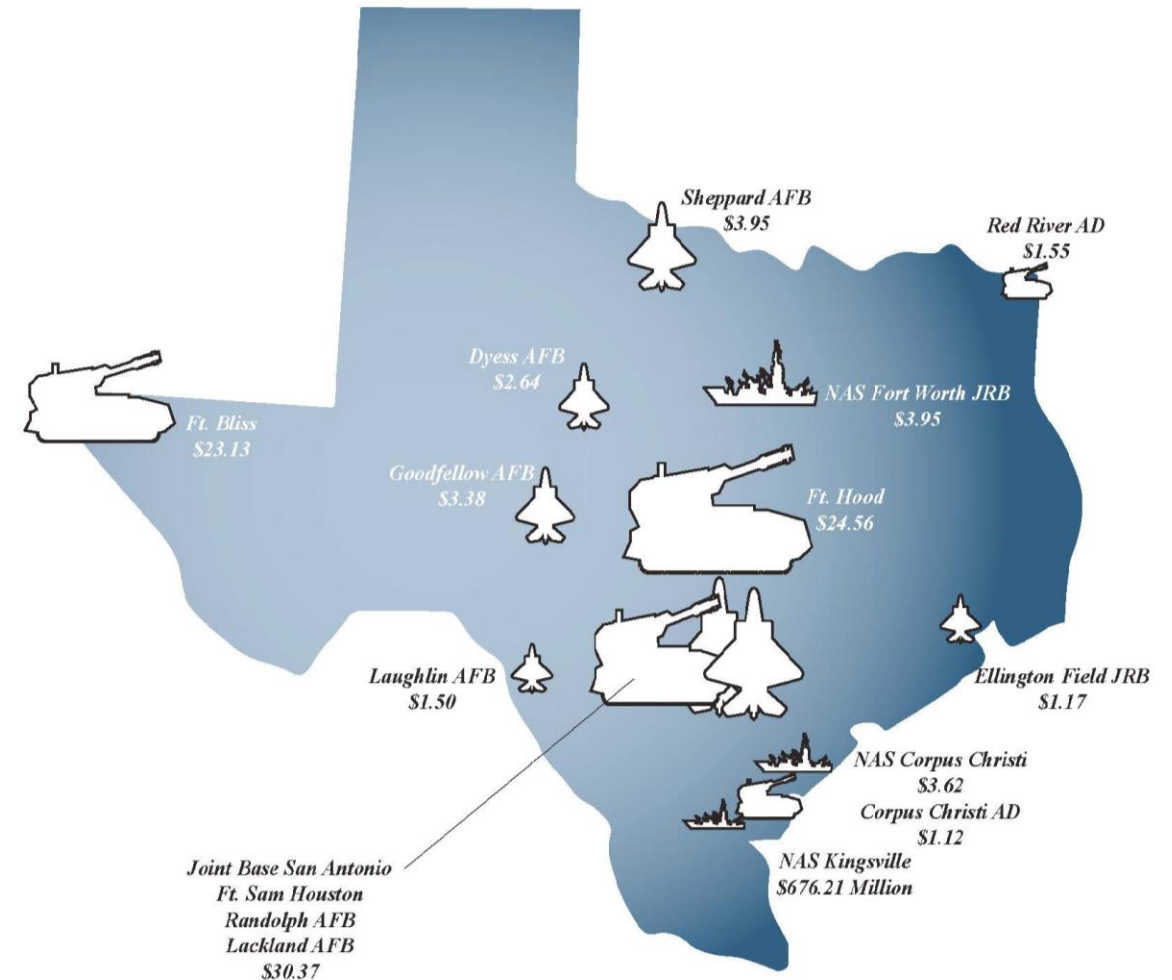


The Texas Military Footprint and Economic Impact*

 - 15,000 National Guard and Reserves
- 24,000 students
