

Completed Enhanced EVM Implementation (GAO CAP)

- Issued policy outlining the new requirements
- Improved EVM flow-down for contracts
- Required EVM reporting at Agency level reviews
- Enhanced contracted EVMS surveillance with DCMA and internal NASA resources
- Required Integrated Program Management Report (IPMR) submittals to a central repository
- Enhanced In-house EVMS Surveillance



EVMS Surveillance at NASA – Three Perspectives

- Contracted EVMS Surveillance ensure delegation to DCMA
- Major suppliers where DCMA does not have an existing presence
 - ✓ Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL)
 - ✓ Applied Physics Laboratory (APL)
 - ✓ Southwest Research Institute (SwRI)
 - ☐ Laboratory for Atmospheric & Space Physics (LASP)
- Agency level In-house EVMS Surveillance on select projects



IBR Improvement Initiative

- Goal to improve the overall IBR process
 - Standardize process, where possible, for consistency
 - EVM Focal Points engaged to provide guidance to programs/projects
 - Customers committed to ensuring program/project teams are engaged in the IBR process
 - Continue to update training and handbooks annually
 - Continue to capture lessons learned and best practices
 - Continue to populate the NASA IBR Findings database
