



## **BACKGROUND**

- SBIR: Small Business Innovation Research
- STTR: Small Business Technology Transfer
- The SBIR program was established under the Small Business Innovation Development Act of 1982 (P.L. 97-219)
- Over 195,000 awards have been made totaling more than \$54.3 billion
- Small Business Administration (SBA) has oversight
- All Federal Agencies with \$100M+ extramural RDT&E budget must have a SBIR Program
- Over \$4B per year
  - FY2020 Breakdown of Grants vs. Contracts across the U.S. Government (USG)



### **MISSION**

- The mission of the SBIR/STTR programs is to support scientific excellence and technological innovation through the investment of Federal research funds in critical American priorities to build a strong national economy
- The program's goals are to:
  - Stimulate technological innovation
  - Meet Federal research and development needs
  - Foster and encourage participation in innovation and entrepreneurship by women and socially or economically disadvantaged persons
  - Increase private-sector commercialization of innovations derived from Federal research and development funding
- In addition, the STTR program aims to:
  - Foster technology transfer through cooperative Research & Development (R&D) between small businesses and research institutions

# SBIR vs. STTR

	SBIR	STTR
Federal Agencies	11 Agencies: DoD* (13 Components), DHS, NSA, USDA, Commerce, Education, DoE, HHS, DoT, EPA, NSF	5 Agencies: DoD (13 Components), DoE, HHS, EPA, NSF
Partnership	Not required	Small business required to partner with a non-profit, college/university or research institution (RI)
Focus	Small business Research & Development	Focused on the transfer of technology from the RI to small business to the marketplace
Principal Investigator (PI)	Must be primarily employed at the proposing small business	Could be primarily employed at either the RI or the small business
Subcontracting	33% limit on Phase I SBIR subcontracting, increases to 50% in Phase II	Up to 60% of the research effort can be subcontracted



### SBIR PARTNER INTERMEDIARIES AGREEMENT PILOT

#### **PROBLEMS:**


- Non-traditional small businesses limitation in proposing to SOCOM's SBIRs
- Administrative lead time decreasing productivity and efficiency


#### **APPROACH:**


- Current Authority: FY22 NDAA Sec 852, "Pilot Program for Development of Technology-Enhanced Capabilities with partnership Intermediaries"
- SBIR awards via SOCOM Partner Intermediary (SOFWERX)
- 30 days or less Phase I to Phase II evaluation and award period
- Expand Small Business outreach through SOFWERX and social media outlets

#### **RESULTS:**

- Over 200% Increase in proposals in FYs 20 & 21
- Average of 74% decrease in award time for FYs 20 & 21
- A 50% decrease in time from Phase I award to Prototype
- Two Phase III awards (compared to an average of over 46 months)
  - Phase I to Phase III in 17 months
  - Phase II to Phase III in 11 months

#### **Disadvantaged Small Business:**

- In FY19, USSOCOM had 14.3% Disadvantaged Small Business.
- In FY20, USSOCOM had 100% of the PIA Legislative Proposal awards were diverse per definition.
- FY21: 80% diversity on PIA Legislative Proposal awards.



# SOCOM SBIR/STTR PARTICIPATION

### **Phase I (Feasibility Study):**

- Up to \$150k
- 5 Page proposal, 15 slide presentation, cost proposal
- 6 months or less

### **Phase II (Proof of Concept/Prototyping):**

- Follow-on from Phase I (follow RFP instructions)
- Sequential Phase II (follow RFP instructions)
- Direct to Phase II
  - 10 Page proposal, 15 slide presentation, Feasibility Study, cost proposal
- Cost Depends on effort








## ACHIEVING A SUCCESSFUL PROPOSAL

- Following the DoD and SOCOM instructions
  - Recommend a Traceability Matrix
  - DSIP 100% doesn't mean you met all requirements
- Ask questions early
  - SOCOM participates in SITIS Q&A
  - SOCOM Virtual Q&A (topic dependent)
- Focus on technology requested
