INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY INTEGRATION (ISI)

- Ensuring the RIGHT ITEMS are available at the RIGHT TIME AND PLACE
- Leverages data analytics, technology, and best practices to achieve cost savings by eliminating wasted time materials
- Lower USMC financial risk by allowing DLA to purchase material ahead of production via Defense Working Capital Fund
- DLA takes procurement actions ahead of funded requisitions
- Introduction of new forecasting and supply planning capabilities; formalization of improved readiness through DLA investments in hard-toprocure items
- Annual Warehouse Labor Savings: Approximately \$22.5 million
- Over-Procurement Avoided (CY 2023): Nearly \$4.5 million
