

Government Follow-Up Session – IPMDAR DID

- **Dates:** 6,7 and 8, March
- Attendees: OSD, Service and Agency Leads
- Topics:
 - Service/Agency focal points presented IPMDAR Lessons Learned
 - Determined if additional updates are required based on lessons learned
 - Reviewed current Draft DID focus on Tailorable Elements
 - Presented DEI/FFS Update (changes to format and addition of clarification of nullable fields)

Government Meeting

Dates: 17-18 Jan 2024

Agenda:

- Team reviewed 167 terms and compared definitions across multiple sources (e.g. DAU, EVMSIG, EVMIG, DOE, NDIA)
- Team adjudicated about ½ of the terms at the in-person meeting
- Additional TEAMS meeting was called on 02 FEB 2024 to assign remaining terms
- We met on TEAMS on 20-21 FEB 2024 and reviewed the remaining terms

Path Forward:

- Sub team is working on approximately 25 terms
- Full team to review 25 terms around 17 APR 2024 to complete the glossary
- IPM Glossary will be provided to key stakeholders for review/comment
- Publish finalized guide to the ADA IPM Division website





Section 827. Modifications to Earned Value Management System Requirements

- Exempt all software contracts and subcontracts of the DoD from EVMS requirements
- ADA meeting with Staffers
 - Staffers expressed concern over the management of software contracts
 - ADA to provide a letter on implementing "Agile EVM" or "Agile IPM"
 - ADA to provide a written explanation on the EVM Applicability
 Determination process being a risk-based evaluation on the omission of the EVMS clause from any contract, including software



FY24 NDAA – Re: EVMS Thresholds



Section 827. Modifications to Earned Value Management System Requirements


- Impose EVMS requirements for cost contracts or incentive contracts with a value greater or equal to \$20M and less than \$50M
- Require a defense contractor to use EVMS for contracts awarded with a value greater than or equal to \$50M and less than \$100M
- ADA meeting with Staffers
 - The intent was to increase the lower end threshold from \$20M to \$50M
 - The language will be updated in the FY25 NDAA, no further action





EVM-CR Release (8 Feb, 2024)

- Color change no more EVM Red
- Added ability to search submissions by file type (e.g., IPMDAR)
- Various updates to Data Views and Charts
