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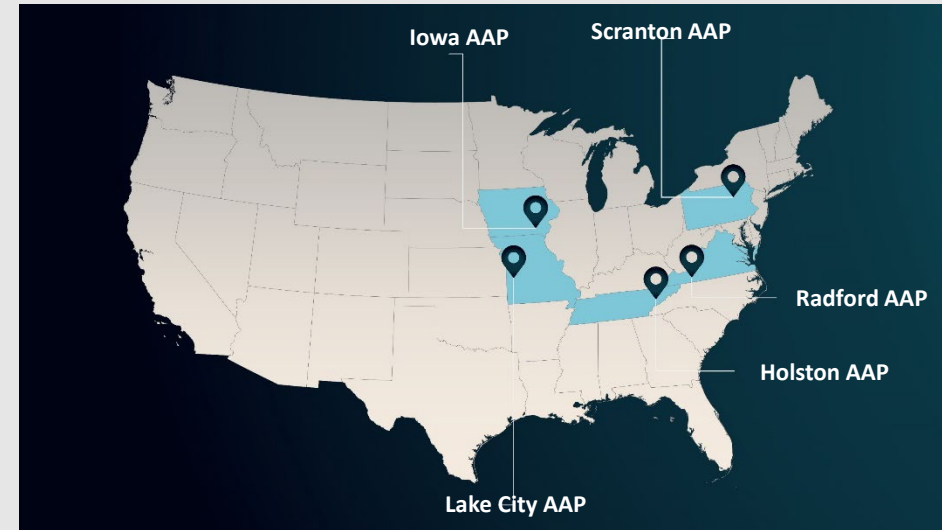


## Mission

## Recent Accomplishments

- ❑ Modernization Program contains over 133 projects in execution.
- ❑ Total Budget for 155mm investments \$2.7 Billion.
- ❑ Utilized Section 1244a Authorities on 11 UCAS; increased Scranton Army Ammunition Plant Ceiling from \$214M to \$1,477M.
  - Accelerates project schedules by approximately 12 months.
- ❑ Supported 26 UCAs/UCOs across the modernization portfolio.
- ❑ Began installation on the first of three Universal Artillery Projectile Lines to double U.S. 155mm Metal parts capability.
- ❑ Holston Army Ammunition Plant awarded BAE a new 10-year with 2, 5-year options facility/supply contract.
- ❑ The M6 propellant line has been requalified and production has started at Radford Army Ammunition Plant.
- ❑ Next Gen Squad Weapon (NGSW) Facility Value Engineering Effort executed at Lake City Army Ammunition Plant
