 - Next Generation Cannon and Howitzer (Weapon Platforms)
 - Cannon-Delivered Area Effects Munitions (anti-armor and Dual Purpose Improved Conventional Munitions (DPICM) replacement)
 - 6.8mm Ammunition for the Next Generation Squad Weapon
 - Terrain Shaping Obstacle
 - Counter Unmanned Aerial Systems (C-UAS)
- Leading effort to ensure Assured Position, Navigation, and Timing (A-PNT) Precision and Conventional Fires in GPS Degraded/Denied environments
 - Assured Precision Weapons and Munitions (including A-PNT, M-Code Global Positioning System (GPS), Network Assisted A-PNT (NA2), Alternative Navigation (AltNav) and non-GPS solutions)
