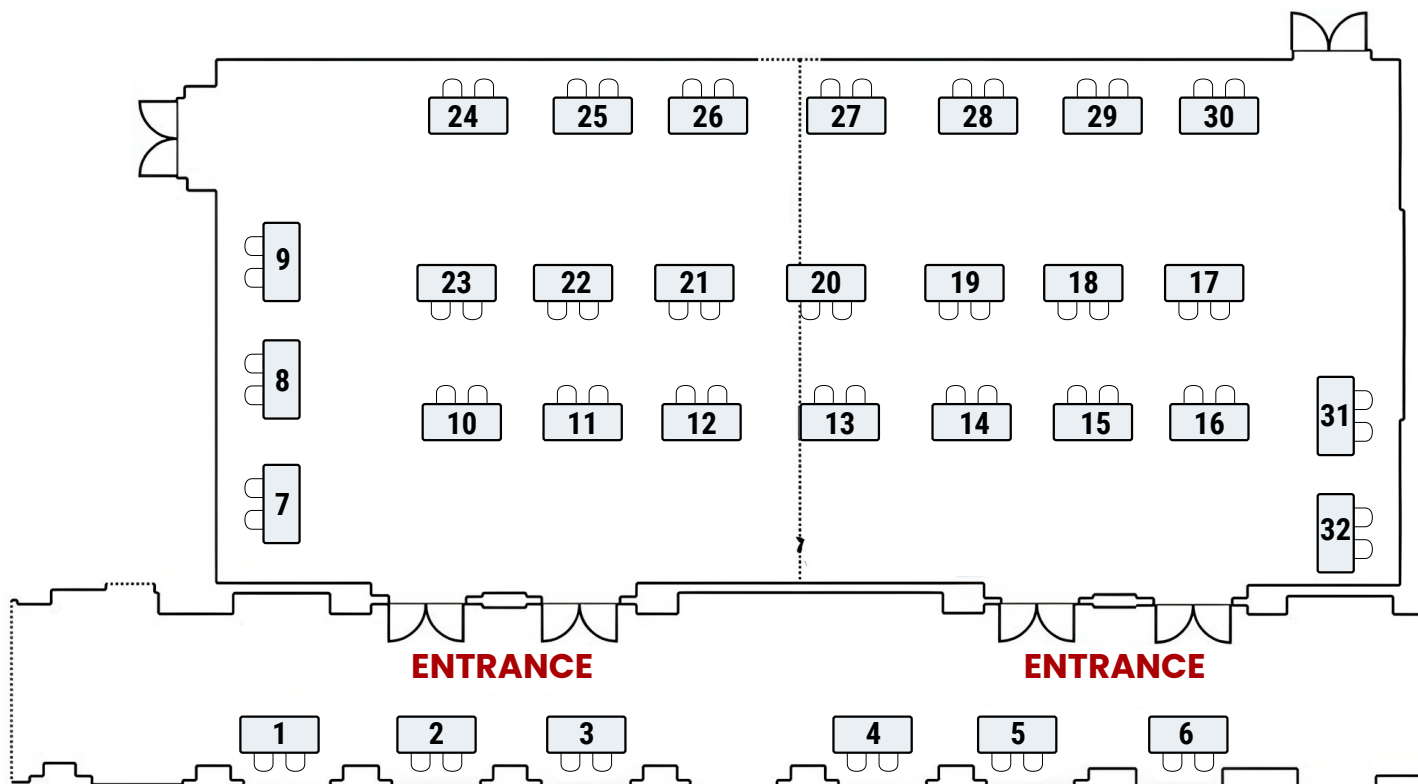
The NDIA has a policy of strict compliance with federal and state antitrust laws.
