

Advanced Multi-Purpose (AMP) Full Rate Production (FRP)



- Approved by JPEO A&A on 20 Dec 24
- In addition to reduce logistic burden, provides Abrams crew new capabilities against ATGM teams out to 2km and Double Reinforced Concrete Walls (DRCW) breach
- Underscores the Army's ongoing overmatched lethality commitment to Soldiers and International Partners
- Significant Industry opportunity to support FMS orders







120mm, M829A4 Armor Piercing, Fin Stabilized Discarding Sabot with Tracer (APFSDS-T)



- 5th generation 120mm Kinetic Energy (KE) Armor Piercing Fin Stabilized Discarding Sabot with Tracer (APFSDS-T) Cartridge
- Utilizes Depleted Uranium (DU) penetrator to defeat current and future enemy Main Battle Tanks (MBTs)
- Integration of leap ahead technologies
 - Utilizes Surface-Coated Double Base (SCDB) propellant for temperature insensitivity
 - Advanced penetrator design
- New PY6 Firm Fixed Price (FFP) contract being planned for award in Apr 2025 and will cover FY25-28

Perpetua Gold Mine – Antimony Sulfide



- Stibnite Gold Project seeks to restart mining operations in Stibnite, ID
- Mine will also produce Antimony Sulfide, a critical material in ammunition production
 - Effort represents nearest-term solution for secure, reliable domestic source of Antimony Sulfide
- **STATUS**: Final Record of Decision received JAN 2025
 - Key milestone towards eventual start of mine construction
- PM MAS developing process to refine raw antimony ore into military-grade material for ammunition production



Medium Caliber Family Buy Industry Day



Tentatively planning for 28-29 May 2025

Intent:

- Help inform the next Medium Caliber Ammunition Acquisition Strategy
- Assess current and potential medium caliber Industry partners
- Provide Industry with product type information to inform future

Medium Caliber Family Buy 1-3 has restricted competition

- Results in single source of supply for multiple ammunition types
- Strategy currently being updated to incentivize cost, performance, and industrial base

Potential outcomes:

- New contractual structure
 - Multiple contracts (caliber specific or functionality vs. requirement to produce all)
 - Small Business Set Aside
- Expanded Industrial Base
- Increased competition to drive down risk
